DENTAL TREATMENT

Dear students,

Given that there are more and more situations where acute or preventive treatment is required in the oral cavity, certain recommendations have been drawn up to guide you:

1) ACUTE CONDITION

Mostly it is an acute disease of the pulp of the tooth or inflammation in the bone (night pain, pain does not respond to painkillers, swelling, it is not possible to "bite", wisdom tooth complications, complications after extractions).


It is necessary to visit a dentist as soon as possible - preferably for an immediate acute treatment.

- Please have your passport and insurance card (blue EHIC or comprehensive health insurance by pVZP) on you
- A fee of 90 CZK for emergency service (given by the Czech law) is to be paid
- In case not every step of treatment is payed from your insurance = very unlikely!!!, have cash or card on you approx. 1000 CZK)

2) APPOINTMENT FOR AN EXAMINATION AND TREATMENT

The Institute of Dentistry and Oral Sciences / Klinika zubního lékařství is primarily a teaching workplace and all interventions are performed by or with the assistance of Dentistry students during the academic year.

Preventive examination, follow-up care after an acute dental emergency treatment, treatment of carious lesion, planned treatment of tooth root canal system, etc. are performed at:

The Institute of Dentistry and Oral Sciences / Klinika zubního lékařství
Operative Dentistry Department / Konzervační zubní lékařství – side entrance, 3rd floor

For prosthodontic treatment (indirect crown reconstruction - onlay, inlay, dental crowns, dental implants etc.) and extractions you will be directed to the Department of Prosthodontics / Protetické zubní lékařství in the same building at Palackého 12 street – main entrance, 2nd floor



FOR ALL THESE NON-ACUTE TREATMENTS:

- Please have your passport and insurance card (blue EHIC or comprehensive health insurance by pVZP) on you
- There are usually only codes for acute treatment (e.g. X-ray, anesthesia, etc.) included in the European insurance (blue EHIC) or in the comprehensive insurance by pVZP
- Other interventions must be paid in cash or via card!
