ACADEMIC CALENDAR LESSONS AND EXAMS	I semester: early September: begin Italian language courses end of September: Welcome week and Faculties Welcome day early October: begin lessons end January: end lessons February: exams (winter session)  II semester: early February: begin of Italian language courses early February: Welcome week and Faculties Welcome dayearly March: begin of lessons end May: end of lessons June/July/September: exams (summer session)

	There are 5 degree courses in "Medicina e Chirurgia" of which 4 are Italian language courses ("A", "B", "C", "D") and 1 English language course ("F"), all located in Rome at the Hospital Policlinico Umberto I/Sapienza Campus. There is also another Italian language course in Medicine and Surgery "E" located in the peripheral site of Sapienza in Latina, which is a town 100 km far from Rome.  The criteria by which we divide the incoming medical students in the various courses in Italian ("A", "B", "C", "D") is that all the students coming from the same country are assigned to the same degree course.  This is the subdivision of the students in the "Medicina e Chirurgia" Italian language courses according to the following criteria:

	Course A: Austria, Cyprus, Germany, Portugal, Norway
MEDICINE AND SURGERY	Course B: Belgium, Denmark, France, Netherlands, Czech Republic, Greece,
	Swiss
	Course C: Croatia, Poland, Slovenia, Slovakia, Turkey, Hungary, Romanian, Bulgaria, Lithuania
	Course D: Spain, UK
	As for the English language course "F", the number of places is limited to 6 medical students per semester.  The admission criterion is the following: the first 6 students who reply to a specific email that we send simultaneously to all incoming students at a specific time, are included in the English language course
	For <b>Nursing</b> there are 4 degree courses (A-B-C-D) located at the Hospital Policlinico Umberto I Roma.  Incoming students will be distributed in the different courses as shown below:

MIDWIFERY, PHYSIOTHERAPY, SPEECH THERAPY, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, PSYCHOMOTRICITY, DENTAL HYGIENE, NUTRITION, BIOMEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNIQUES, NURSING AND MIDWIFE SCIENCES	For each of these degree courses there is only one degree course, in which the incoming students will be automatically inserted.  These coursed are in Rome at the Hospital Policlinico Umberto I/Sapienza Campus.
DENTISTRY	For Dentistry there are 2 degree courses, 1 in Italian language and 1 in English language.  The course in English has only been active for two years, so there are not yet lessons for all 6 years.  These courses are in Rome at the Hospital Policlinico Umberto I/Sapienza Campus.
	WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND A GOOD KNOWLEDGE OF THE ITALIAN LANGUAGE (MINIMUM B1 LEVEL), EVEN IF WE DON'T REQUIRE A MANDATORY CERTIFICATION.
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	All lessons and exams are taught in Italian, except Medicine and Surgery "F" and Dentistry in English.
	The internship is always in Italian, because it requires a relationship with the patient, even for courses taught in English.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES	Italian Intensive Language Courses for the duration of 1 month (3 ECTS credits incl. in transcript) are offered <b>in September and February</b> before the start of the semester.  Also, Italian extensive Courses for the duration of 10 weeks during the semester are offered.  THE ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES ARE FREE.
BUDDY PROGRAM	Buddies are students interested in supporting international exchange students as unpaid volunteers during their time in Rome.
WELCOME WEEK	It is strongly suggested that all incoming students should participate in the Welcome Week organized at the beginning of each semester (September and February)
